## GENERAL LOGISTICS

Travel Logistics to Yenagoa for Practical Nigerian Content (PNC) 2023 Conference

### **1. Flights from other locations to Port Harcourt:**

- Several airlines operate flights from Lagos, Abuja, and other locations to Port Harcourt International Airport (PHC). Flights are available daily, with multiple schedules throughout the day.

### **2. Flights from other locations to Yenagoa:**

- The only airline operating flights from Lagos and Abuja to Bayelsa International Airport (BIA) is United Nigeria. Flights were available daily, with multiple schedules throughout the day until recently when flights now have a two-day schedule – Mondays and Wednesdays.

- United Nigeria Airlines flight plies Lagos to Yenagoa, Yenagoa to Lagos, and Abuja to Yenagoa, Yenagoa to Abuja on Mondays. On Wednesdays, the flight schedule is Lagos to Yenagoa, Yenagoa to Lagos. Regular daily flights are envisaged to resume during PNC 2023. All flights have an average flight duration of approximately 60 minutes.

### **3. Land Transport from Port Harcourt to Yenagoa:**

- For those preferring ground transportation, road travel from Port Harcourt to Yenagoa is possible via East-West Road of approximately 95.2 kilometres.

- Private taxi services and car rental options are available at Port Harcourt International Airport (PHC), offering a convenient way to travel by road. The journey takes approximately 2 hours, depending on traffic conditions.

## **4. Land Transport from Warri to Yenagoa:**

· Travellers coming from Warri can also opt for road transport to Yenagoa. Private car hire service or buses are available from Warri to Yenagoa via Orho Agberho – Patani Road, covering a distance of about 135.4 kilometres taking approximately 3 hours, depending on the route and traffic.

## **5. Accommodation in High-Profile Hotels in Yenagoa:**

· Yenagoa offers several high-profile hotels and accommodations catering to diverse preferences and budgets. Some recommended hotels suitable for conference attendees include:

- **Royal Castle Golden Tulip:** A luxury hotel offering comfortable rooms, modern amenities, and conference facilities, having a panoramic view of the Bayelsa Golf Club situated within the precinct of the Creek Haven – Government House, Yenagoa.
- **Golden Tulip Annex:** Known for its elegance and top-notch services, with proximity to the conference venue, and situated within the posh apartments of the Government House, Onopa – venue for the PNC 2023 Youth Forum.
- **The Tap Tallen Hotel:** A prestigious hotel offering luxurious accommodations and exquisite facilities within earshot of the conference venue at the Nigerian Content Tower on Oxbow Lake Road, Swali.

Yenagoa which situates in an area of swamps and mangrove tropical rainforest experiences [unpleasant weather all year round, with the wet season being warm](#)

and cloudy and the dry season being hot and generally cloudy with sporadic rainfall most hours of the day. The rain pattern is most often convectional with an uneven spread across the locality. The average annual temperature fluctuates between 22°C and 31°C, rarely falling below 17°C or rising over 32°C.
